- The crucible and Bessemer processes, and pioneering stainless steel innovations made Sheffield steel famous worldwide.

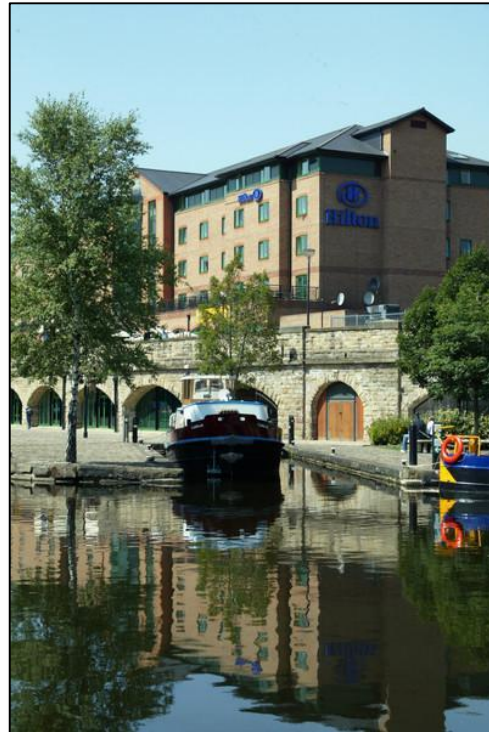

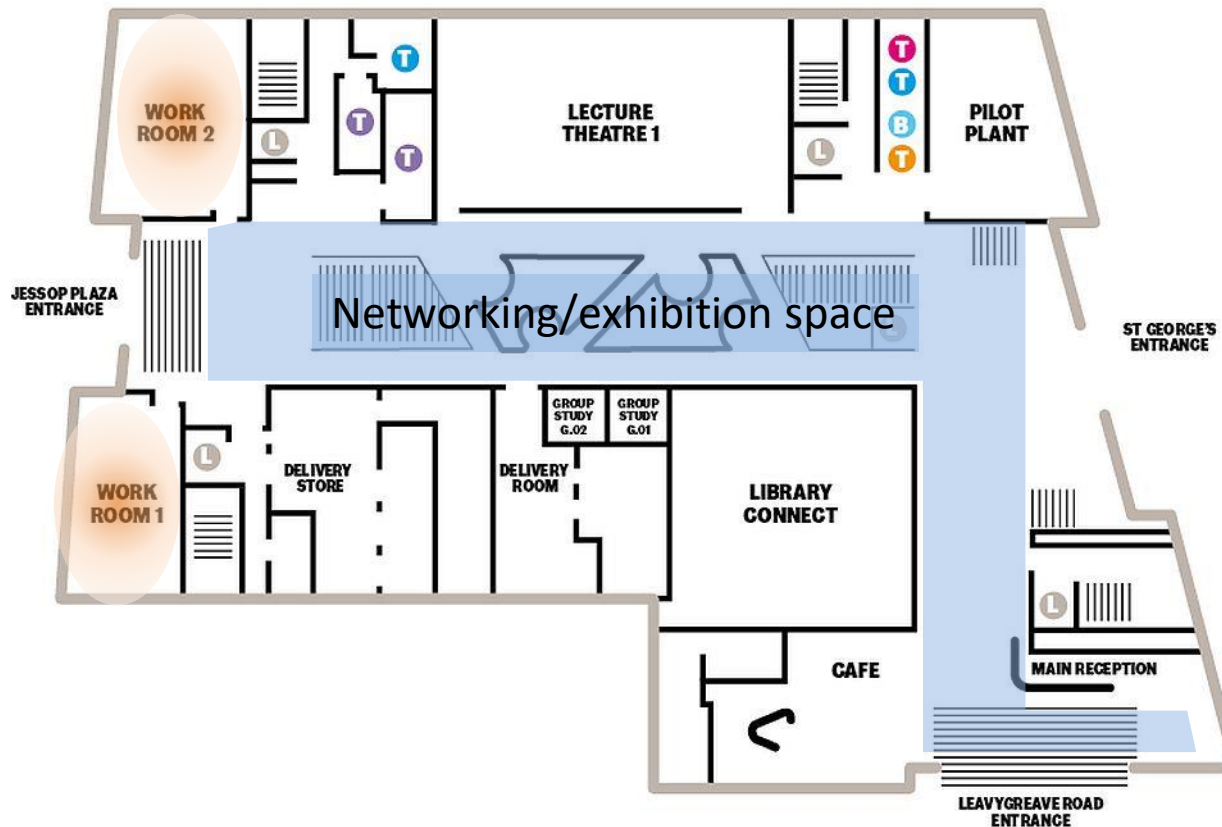

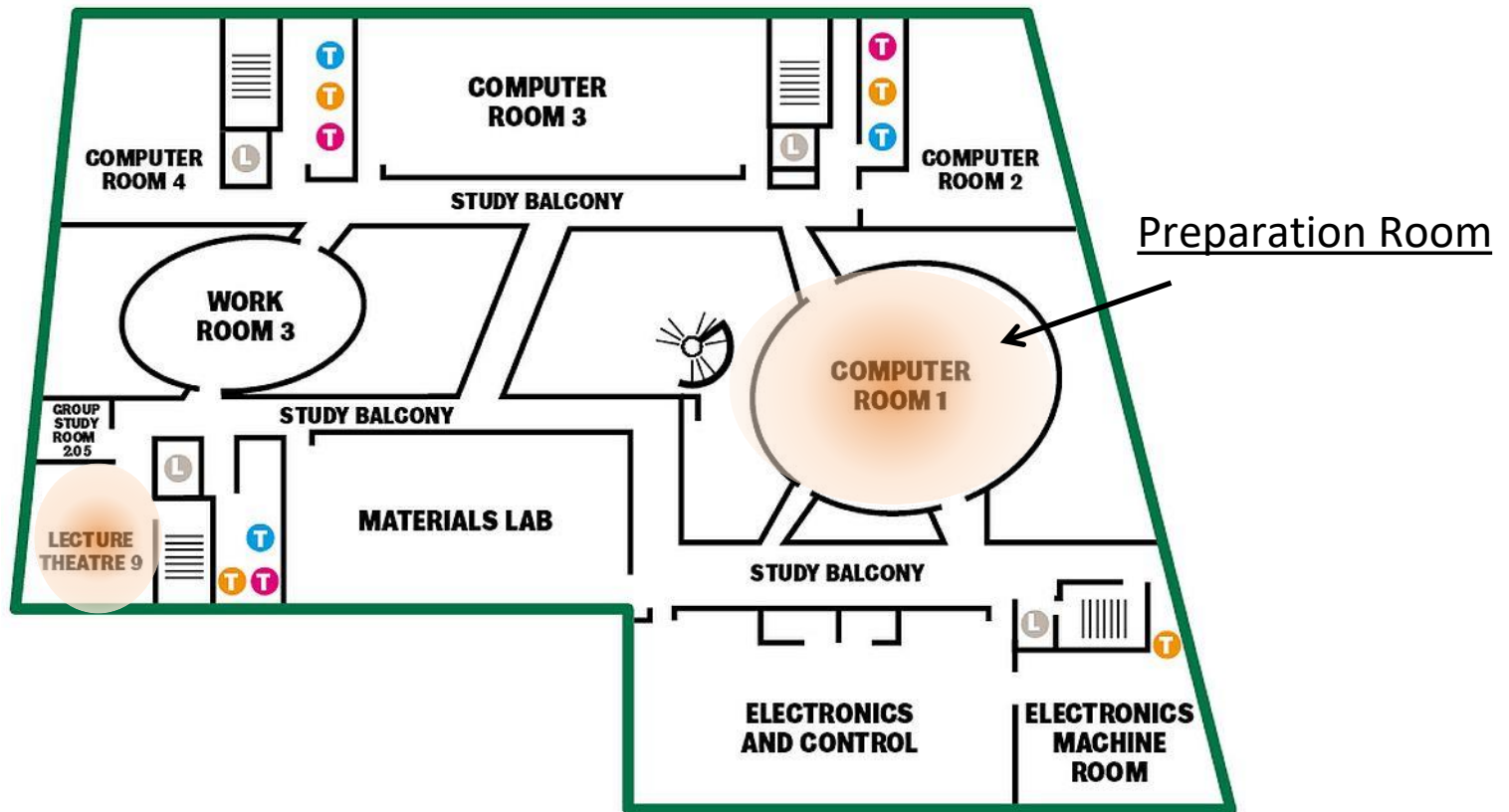


Ground floor

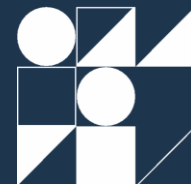
